This report, taken in concert with the state issued School Accountability Report, annual budgets and audit reports, minutes of meetings of the Board of Education and periodic other means of public communication, paints a picture of what is happening at Crowley County School District. The Board of Education, Administration and Staff of Crowley County School District are committed to open communication about how and why we operate the schools of the District.

Please keep in mind that this report is based on the data from our last school year (2008-2009). Using this data to guide our decisions this fall, we have developed school improvement plans with changes in place to improve the performance of our schools.

Description of Our Schools

Crowley County School District has a student population of 503 which includes K through 12th grade students. While our student population has been higher in the past, our numbers are declining yearly. We have three buildings- Crowley County Elementary, Ward Middle School and Crowley County High School. The majority of our students come from four areas of the county- Olney Springs, Crowley, Ordway and Sugar City. All of our district facilities except for one gymnasium in Sugar City are located in Ordway, Colorado.

Crowley County School District has over 100 full-time and parttime employees that serve students in a variety of needs. The majority of employees provide instruction for Crowley County's students. The rest focus on support services such as custodial, food preparation and transportation.

Crowley County School District provides a wide variety of learning experiences for students who attend our schools. Students receive instruction in core courses of math, science, reading, writing and social studies as well as a number of electives in subjects such as art, music, band, PE, knowledge bowl, foreign language, and drama. Crowley County School District serves a high number of at-risk students, especially relating to socio-economic status. Our free and reduced lunch rates for the 2007-2008 school year is at 65%. The state average is 30.2%.




Out-of-School Suspensions:

Student Performance on CSAP


The 2008-2009 Colorado State Assessment Program (CSAP) included assessments in Reading, Writing and Math in grades 3-10, and Science assessment in grades 5,8 and 10. In addition, all 11th

grade students were administered the ACT as part of the state-wide program. This expanded assessment program allows us to more accurately measure the growth of our students from year to year, and to use the results of these assessments to guide our instructional program to better meet the needs of all of our students.


Crowley County's accreditation contract with the State Board of Education requires the reporting of certain elements regarding student performance. This includes overall student performance by grade and subject level, student performance by student group (demographics), performance over time (trends) and comparison to state averages. The following tables provide information on the percentage of students performing at the Advanced and Proficient levels.

The increasing emphasis on "leaving no child behind" seems to dictate a "sorting" of students by various demographic categories to identify potential achievement gaps. The primary demographic disaggregating of our student population is based on gender and ethnicity groups to break out which we must do according to State regulations.


