12. Superintendent's Report

1. The preliminary budget was discussed during the worksession. The board discussed the power point which showed the projected revenue and cuts for the 2010-2011 school year. We hope to keep this at a zero based budget. A few of the items that were discussed were:
    - Our state equalization will be down by about \$3,031,000
    - Property and Specific Ownership tax will be up about \$1,300
    - Federal Grants will be down at least \$18,000
    - Insurance Reserve Trans was increased to cover Insurance expenses
    - Other grants line item was decreased for next year because we know that some of the grants we received in the 09-10 school year are no longer available.
    - Salaries have been reduced and the pay scale was frozen.
    - A few positions have been eliminated and others have been re-assigned to grant dollars.
  2. We are trying out new custodial schedules to see what will work best for next year, right now we are on a 2 team split. Tony is doing a great job at his new assignment.
  3. EMC has suggested that we get a maintenance contract with a company to take care of our HVAC system. We have had 2 companies show an interest so we will work up the specs and put this out for bid.
  4. We have not heard anything from Kenyon Energy in the past week.
  5. The Commissioner of Education is coming to the BOCES meeting to talk about his decision to allow Florence to leave our BOCES and to see if CDE can come up with a solution to the financial hard ship this is putting on the other schools in the South Central BOCES. Our BOCES payment will go up \$25,000 for the 2010-2011 school year and then up will go up around \$67,000 more the following year. There is a big jump for the 2011-2012 school year because ARRA funds will be used to off set part of the 2010-2011 school year cost but ARRA will not be available after that date.
