Mr. Gray requested a final printout of the 2011-2012 budget and actual expenses.

Mr. Terrones stated that he has a contact that refurnishes gym floors and has asked that individual to let the school know if he comes across a used wood floor. Mr. Terrones will ask his contact to phone Mr. Cuckow so that he may discuss our options as well.
